**Sub: Plantation activities in the Catchment Areas of Wetlands**


While reviewing the funding activities under various conservation related schemes of the Ministry of Environment and Forests, it was observed that plantation activities in the catchment areas of Wetlands could be funded by the National Afforestation and Eco-Development Board (NAEB), to avoid overlap of financial support.

2. Accordingly, the State Governments are requested to forward the proposal on the component of catchment area treatment under the Management Action Plan (MAP) of the Wetlands through Forest Development Agencies (FDAs) to NAEB as per the National Afforestation Programme (NAP) guidelines for seeking funds. The Joint Forest Management Committee (JFMC) or similar institution would be the implementing agency.

3. In case of Wetlands having no village level institution like JFMC, the community can be encouraged to constitute a JFMC within the jurisdiction of existing FDA as per NAP guidelines and seek funding support for the catchment area treatment.

4. A State-wise list of Wetlands seeking funding support under National Wetland Conservation Programme is enclosed for ready reference.
